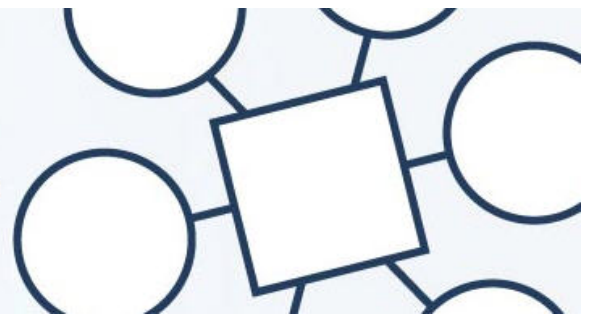


# Graphic Organizer Maker

Make customized graphic organizer worksheets to use in your classroom.



*Graphic organizers help students build a strong foundation of information about a topic. You can use the Graphic Organizer Maker to create printable worksheets your students can use to organize information, make connections between ideas, and even plan a project.*

Click the Instructions field to add instructions students can follow to complete the organizer.

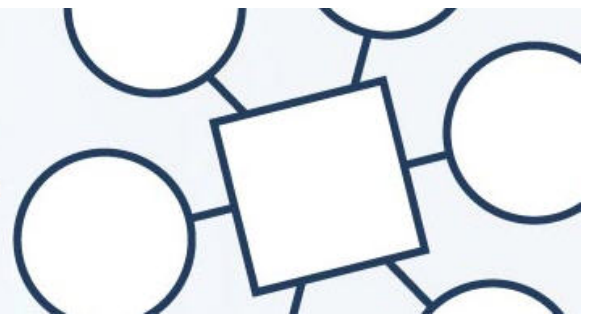

## Instructions:

Write "Fog by Carl Sandburg" next to the circle on the left. Write "The Echoing Green by William Blake" next to the circle on the right. Write words that describe how these two poems are different in the areas that do not overlap. Write words that describe how these two things are similar in the area where the circles overlap.

When you are finished, click the **Print Graphic Organizer** button.



You will see a preview of your organizer.

If you need to make changes to the title or instructions, click the Edit button.



If the preview is what you wish to create, click the **Create a PDF you can save or print** button.

**Create a PDF you can save or print**

The organizer will open as a PDF in a new window.

Use the Adobe Reader controls to download or print the PDF.



Return to the previous window to continue creating graphic organizers.

*Important: You can edit and save new PDFs as long as you keep the browser open. Once you close the browser you will need to begin the process again.*
